

GENERAL CARE

- Rugs in prolonged direct sunlight will fade over time. We recommend protecting your rugs from exposure to direct sunlight.
- To ensure more even wear in high-traffic areas, rotate your rugs once or twice a year.

RUG PADS

Proper care and maintenance can offer your rugs many years of beauty and enjoyment. To further extend the life of your rug, we recommend using one of our luxurious rug pads under any area rug.

- Rug pads prevent slipping & bunching.
- They also provide extra cushioning and comfort underfoot.
- To create a custom fit, simply trim with household scissors.

PET RUGS

Eco-friendly and easy to clean, PET rugs are crafted from finely spun polyester fibers made from recycled plastic bottles. They are naturally stain resistant, and easy to keep looking fresh and new with only minimal effort.

To minimize fading, keep out of direct sunlight for extended periods of time.

- Vacuum your rug regularly using a non-beater bar power head. Regular vacuuming will help reduce any abrasive actions created by dirt and soil.
- Promptly remove liquid spills and soil marks by blotting with a dry clean cloth or paper towel. NEVER rub at a spill, as this will only push the liquids further into the pile.
- If spot persists, use a mild solvent (such as dish soap and water) to clean.
- Apply solvent to cloth then blot gently.
- Simply let air dry.
- For more stubborn stains, please call a professional rug/carpet cleaning service.

WOOL & WOOL BLEND RUGS

Wool and wool blend rugs will last a long time when properly cared for.

- Cut loose yarn knots off even with the rug surface if one is coming out.
- To minimize fading, keep out of direct sunlight for extended periods of time.
- Vacuum your rug regularly using a non-beater bar power head. Regular vacuuming will help reduce any abrasive actions created by dirt and soil.
- Promptly remove liquid spills and soil marks by blotting with a dry clean cloth or paper towel. NEVER rub at a spill, as this will only push the liquids further into the pile.
- Professional carpet cleaning only
- Do not use bleach, optical whiteners, or other harsh chemicals.

HAIR ON HIDE RUGS

Hair on Hide rugs offer a variety of unique patterns and softness underfoot. They are created using small pieces of hide that are then sewn together to create beautiful patterns. Please note - Hair on Hide rugs are natural products, differences are to be expected.

- Care should be used to avoid pulling any yarn knot out of the surface pile. Cut loose yarn knots off even with the rug surface if one is coming out.
- Vacuum regularly without the beater bar. Pile shedding is a normal characteristic.
- Clean spills immediately by blotting with a clean sponge or cloth. Do not leave the spill to dry as even water can leave a mark. A hair dryer can also be used to just dry the water, but only at a far distance--do not use a hair dryer directly on the rug.
- Professional carpet cleaning only
- Do not use bleach, optical whiteners, or other harsh chemicals.
